He worked for 13 years outside of academia and immediately prior to moving to UA, he served at Mississippi State University as Director of the Institute for Genomics, Biocomputing and Biotechnology as well as Professor and Associate Dean for Strategic Initiatives & Economic Development for its College of Veterinary Medicine.

His primary research areas are systems and genomic biology, bioinformatics, immunology and virology; his funded research areas include cancer biology, immunology, virology, vaccine production, bacteriology, toxicology, bioenergy, agriculture and biotechnology. He has eight patents, eight software copyrights, and 115 academic papers.
